





THIS CHRISTCHURCH HOME, BUILT IN ELEMENTAL CONCRETE BLOCK, STANDS STRONG IN ITS ENVIRONMENT

uckland-based architect Malcolm Walker is exceptionally modest when it comes to describing the design for his first Christchurch home. "It's a square box," he states.

Essentially a square box it might be, but the design for this concreteblock home in the suburb of Merivale had judges of the New Zealand Institute of Architects Resene Canterbury Local Award for Architecture seeing outside of the square — the building scooped an award.

With their children having flown the nest, Roger and Gill Stokes were looking to downsize from their previous five-bedroomed home. The couple wanted a functional home that made the most of the light and sunshine offered in Christchurch. Keen collectors of art, they also wanted a gallery space in which to display their works.

With these requirements in mind, Malcolm set about designing Roger and Gill's ideal home. Faced with a 365-square-metre section facing on to a busy road, his first challenge was to make the most of the north-facing site, at the same time minimising noise and maximising privacy. He has achieved this by using heavier-than-usual laminated glass in conjunction with concrete blocks.

In fact, Malcolm's description of the house as "a square box, just a concrete block" is not entirely inaccurate. Constructed primarily from grey concrete blocks, the external appearance is softened by the use of wooden slatting and galvanised steel at the entranceway. The exterior
